Prior to joining OFCCP in 2006, Mr. Jordan spent 23 years in the US Air Force, from where he retired a Major. He spent his final six years at the Pentagon, the last three of which he served as both the Director of Minority and Female Outreach Programs and Deputy Director of Military Equal Opportunity, in the Office of the Deputy Undersecretary of Defense for Equal Opportunity. His previous assignments included a 3 year tour as Chief of the Headquarters Air Force Personnel Training & Resource Team (at the Pentagon), where he was responsible for programming and execution of a \$2.2B budget; Squadron Section Commander of a 273 person mission support organization; Regional Director of Recruiting for a six-state region; and Director of Military Personnel (both at home and while deployed).

He holds a Master's Degree in Public Personnel Management, a Bachelor's degree in Business & Technology Management, and two Associate's degrees. Additionally he is a graduate of the Defense Equal Opportunity Management Institute and has successfully completed numerous professional certifications and leadership training courses.
